### **About High School Visitation (HSV):**

The spring session of the program targets high school juniors, though sophomores are invited to apply as well. Students who have previously applied to HSV, are in the targeted grade level, and demonstrate a strong interest in engineering through their essay will receive priority acceptance. Interested students may be selected so spend Saturday night (the 9th) in UVA dorms with first-year SWE members.
