To be a Snow Queen candidate, you must:

- Be a high school junior girl graduating in the spring of 2020.
- Show a passion for working with children of all ages, abilities, and backgrounds.
- Serve as a role model for young girls through your character and commitment to the museum's mission of inspiring creativity and individuality.
- Exhibit balance between academics, community service, and sports.
- Have grades in good standing.
- Submit two letters of recommendation: One from the school you are currently attending and one from another non-family member. (volunteer, work, sports, etc.)
- Be able to volunteer at least 50 hours as CMoR's Snow Queen during her reigning year (required by CMoR), including, but not limited to the following dates:
 - Snow Queen Interviews: November 14th-17th, 2018
 - Snow Queen Coronation and Meet & Greets: January 12th, 2019
 - Reading Month: 1 weekend (Saturday and Sunday) in March 2019
 - Down on the Farm Day: 1 Saturday in June 2019
 - Christmas in July: July 25th, 2019
 - Santa Teas: Select dates in December 2019
 - Dominion Christmas Parade: December 2019
 - 2020 Snow Queen Coronation: Weekend date in January 2020
- Be willing to make public appearances as Snow Queen for the Children's Museum at all four museum locations, in addition to off-site museum events (as scheduled by CMoR).

5:00pm, on Friday, November 2, 2018.
